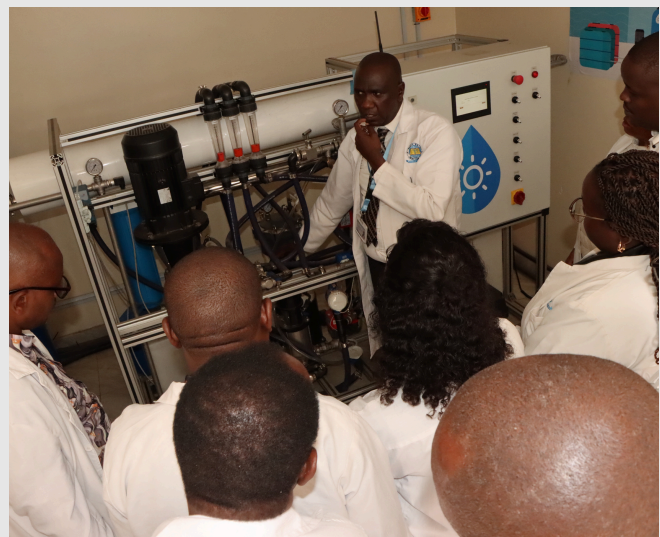

The short courses that Kenya Water Institute offers are geared towards;

Trainees attending are diverse from personnel with considerable experience in the water or related sectors to those with no prior knowledge. The trainers at the Institute are therefore distinguished professionals with appropriate knowledge, training, and above all, rich practical experience in water sector.

The trainees attend the programs at the four KEWI campuses at Chiakariga, Kisumu, Kitui and Nairobi Campuses. Training activities may be conducted at the clients work station or any other preferred venue. KEWI's short courses take a duration of 5 days unless customized upon client's request and needs scope of the content covered especially for special skills professional courses.

The institute has Short courses designed to fill the capacity gap in the sector and may also be custom-made upon request to meet specialized requirements of individuals or institutions. Training dates for all short courses may be scheduled to suit client convenience. Enrolment in all short courses is open all year round.

Upon a successful application, you will receive a letter of offer & an invoice. Charges for 5 days short courses apply as follows:

1. Professional courses - Kshs. 50,000
2. Managerial course – Kshs. 45,000
3. Supervisory courses – Kshs. 35,000
4. Technical courses – Kshs. 30,000
5. International participants - The participants pay 20% above normal rates
6. Tailor-made courses - Based on the duration, scope and client specification

For training in KEWI Nairobi Campus, accommodation arrangements can be made upon request at an extra charge of:

1. Bed Only - Kshs. 4000 per person per night
2. Bed and Breakfast - Kshs. 4500 per person per night
3. Half Board - Kshs. 5000 per person per night (Bed, Breakfast and Dinner)

Charges for consultancy trainings apply as follows:

1. Kshs. 120,000, Kshs.130,000, Kshs.150,000 per day for technical, supervisory and technical levels respectively for a class of maximum of 20 participants .
2. If the training is out of KEWI, other training administrative charges included. (Transport & accommodation charges for the facilitators as per the SRC recommended rate for minimum of three facilitators.)
